



## **Player/Parent Code Of Conduct 2006**

### **Players**

- Players will refrain from using profanity during games and practice.
- Players will not engage in disparaging dialogue with referee, teammates, coaches, opponents or spectators.
- Players will not, under any circumstances, participate in physical violence or threats thereof before, during or after any game or practice.
- Players are prohibited from the use of alcohol or illegal drugs while on the active roster or any TSF Academy team.
- Players will obey the laws of the game and play within the spirit of the laws.
- Players must not exhibit any behavior which maybe regarded as racist, prejudice or offensive to other teammates, opponents, coaches, officials or spectators.
- Players will utilize bathroom facilities and not utilize bushes, shrubs or any other location as lavatories.
- Players should listen and carry out instructions given by the coach to the best of their ability and effort.
- Players are to arrive at the requested times for practice and games.
- Players will shake hands with the referee and their opponents after every game.
- Players are to obey curfew times given by the coaches when away at tournaments.
- Players are to wear correct TSF Academy apparel on match days and at practice. Both cleats and uniform must be clean for every game.

- Players will dispose of all garbage including tape in the required garbage cans at game and practice facilities. It is imperative that fields are left spotless after each usage.
- Players are expected to speak directly with the coaches about any difficulties they might be having with the program. This might include difficulty a player is having in the training sessions or in the games, or dissatisfaction with a particular playing position or playing time. It also might include a relationship with another player on the team. Players are expected to speak privately about such matters with a coach, before or after any team session. Complaining about such matters to others will not resolve the underlying issue – only a direct discussion with the coach will do so.

**Failure to comply with these conditions may result in being removed from the game and future selection, and/or removal from the entire program.**

## **Parents**

- Parents agree to support TSF Academy and their teams in requiring players to abide by the players code of conduct.
- Parents will refrain from verbal abuse of players, coaches, referees, opponents and spectators during or after the game.
- Parents are not to use or possess alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons while attending TSF Academy matches.
- Parents will not engage in giving tactical instruction during games or practice. Dialogue should be limited to encouraging support and comments.
- Parents shall remain in designated spectator areas throughout the duration of the game or practice.
- Parents are to ensure siblings do not go onto the field at anytime throughout and after the game or practice.
- Parents are asked to observe MKA facility regulations, requiring that children stay away from retaining wall and pads, and do not sit on the wall.
- Parents are expected arrive at practice or games at the time requested by the coach to pick up or drop off their child.

- Parents are to follow the parking and any other facility requests at all times.
- Parents are to refrain from commenting negatively about the opponents or referee.
- Parents are not to voice issues concerning their child or coach in front of any other person. If parents need to discuss any issues please contact the team manager/coach at the TSF Academy office.

**Failure to comply with these conditions may result in your son/daughter being removed from the game and future selection.**
